3 FLAGS ARRIVE AND DRIVE KARTING EXPERIENCE

....GET ON TRACK....

At 3 Flags Motorsports Park multi level karting experiences have been developed not unlike professional car racing schools through out the world. Since the same driving techniques apply to both cars and karts, we will teach you the basic concepts in racing and then apply them specifically to racing karts. The program is broken into 3 levels or experiences allowing you to experience the basics, and then if you desire move up into wheel to wheel competition with the SSKC (South Sask Kart Club).

Try a Kart: (on scheduled Friday afternoons/evenings)

The first level of “the karting experience” is open to anyone and will introduce you to the sport of karting. It combines operating instructions and 10 minutes of track time which will give you an opportunity to get the feel of a high performance racing kart.

Basic Requirements and Eligibility:

- You must be a minimum of 12 years of age.
- If you are a minor we will require a signed waiver of consent from both parents.
- You must be at least 5 feet tall in order to fit in karts
- You must not weigh more than 225lbs and be able to fit in the kart seat.

Safety Gear:

- Coveralls to protect your clothing will be provided. When you come to drive, you must have a pair of soft-soled shoes such as runners with preference to having ankle protection.
- Helmets are mandatory, you may bring your own as long as it is in good condition and has full face coverage with working visor. If you don't have a helmet, one will be supplied.

Corporate Karting

Corporate Karting is designed to allow a company or group the opportunity to use karting as a social event. It provides the excitement of motorsports set in a social and safe atmosphere. It combines a short presentation on the sport of Kart Racing, driving instructions and 2 - 10 minute sessions of track time which will give you an opportunity to get the feel of a high performance racing kart. Sessions will run with a maximum of 4 karts on the track at a time. It is recommended that groups be limited to not more than 12 drivers. A food concession is available at the track and special catering can be provided. Completion time is 2 - 3 hours depending on the size of your group.

Basic Requirements and Eligibility:

- You must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
- If you are a minor we will require a signed waiver of consent from both parents.
- You must be at least 5 feet tall in order to fit in karts
- You must not weigh more than 225lbs and be able to fit in the kart seat.

Safety Gear:

- Coveralls to protect your clothing will be provided. When you come to drive, you must have a pair of soft-soled shoes such as runners with preference to having ankle protection.
- Helmets are mandatory, you may bring your own as long as it is in good condition and has full face coverage with working visor. If you don't have a helmet, one will be supplied.

Race School

The race school is open to anyone and will introduce you to the sport of karting. It combines classroom and track time in which you will have an opportunity to get the feel of a high performance racing kart. During the classroom, we will introduce you to the sport of karting, and discuss the basic driving techniques you need in order to get you started out on the race track. We will introduce you to braking techniques and cornering techniques in a controlled environment in order to get you comfortable with the kart. This is a great way to get started in in competition kart racing. Completion time is approximately 4 hours.

Basic Requirements and Eligibility:

- You must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
- If you are a minor we will require a signed waiver of consent from both parents.
- You must be at least 5 feet tall in order to fit in karts
- You must not weigh more than 225lbs and be able to fit in the kart seat.

Safety Gear:

- Coveralls to protect your clothing will be provided. When you come to drive, you must have a pair of soft-soled shoes such as runners with preference to having ankle protection.
- Helmets are mandatory, you may bring your own as long as it is in good condition and has full face coverage with working visor. If you don't have a helmet, one will be supplied.
